Code of Ethics 2007

This code was drawn up on the 9th November 2007 because as a staff we felt there was a need to inform visiting coaches to the school on procedures. A teacher will be present at all times on coaching sessions. We as a school expect the highest standard of behaviour from our children when partaking in coaching activities. Likewise, we would expect the children to be treated in a respectful and professional manner. We will not allow use of inappropriate language and physical contact with our children. Should a discipline problem arise it is the coaches' duty to inform the class teacher immediately.

As with all other school activities lessons need to be pre-planned and taught in a structured manner. It is essential that agreed timetables are adhered to and if for any reason coaches are delayed or lessons are cancelled, it is their duty to contact the school with adequate notice. As the responsibility of a class rests with the class teacher their professionalism must be respected at all times.
